A: Because he was always spotted.

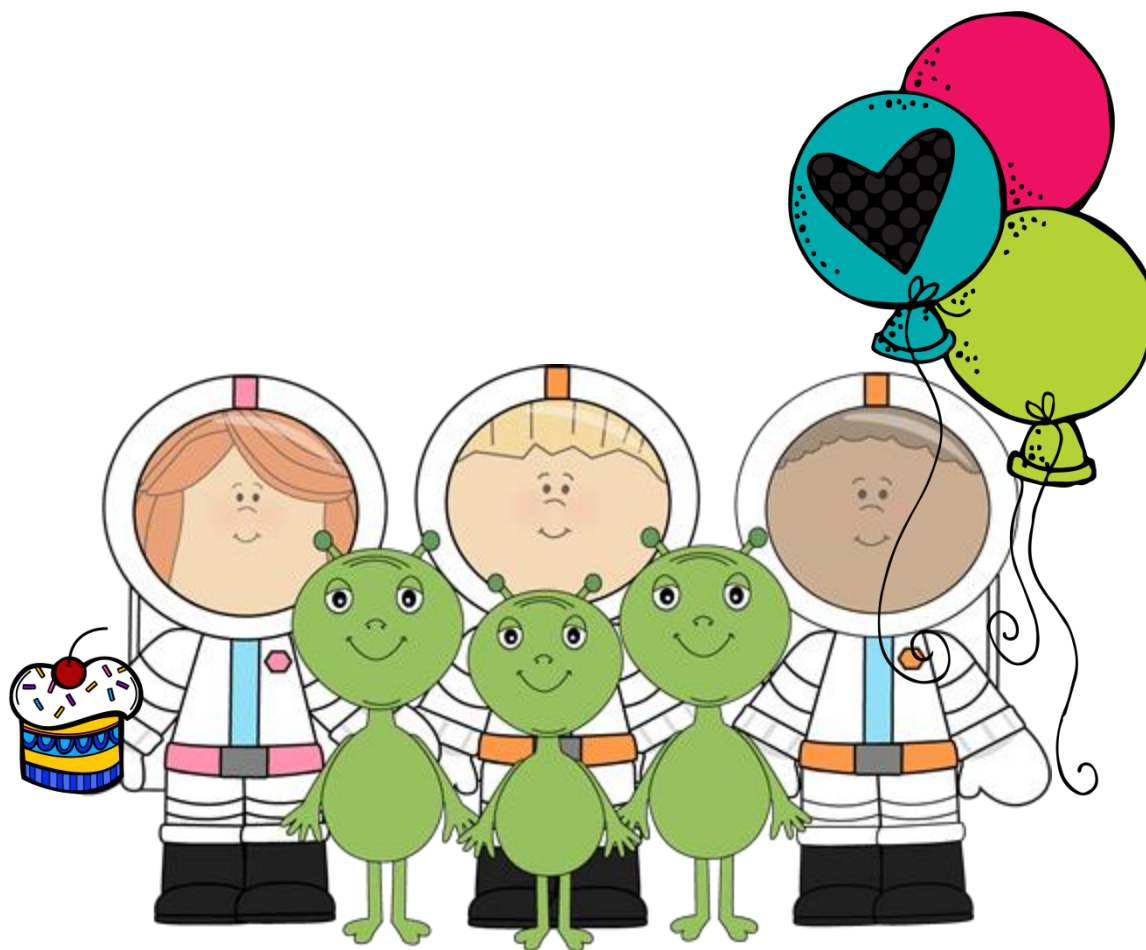

A: The library, because it has so many stories.

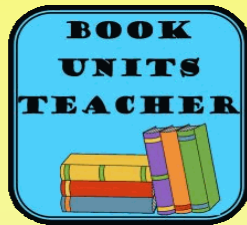

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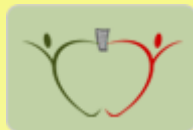


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
